

While there, they had the opportunity to meet with many of New York's Congressional delegation. With all the turmoil that seems to come along with D.C. these days, having farmer members there is vitally important, as they lobbied on such things as the 2018 Farm Bill and agriculture labor.

In March 2018, a group of members represented Schuyler County Farm Bureau at the annual Taste of New York Reception and Lobby Day event held in Albany, NY. The members presented samples of Sunset View Creamery cheese and wine from Lakewood, Hazlitt, Atwater and Barnstormer. They then had the opportunity to speak to our elected officials, as well as our adopted New York City legislators, on many important issues affecting our local agriculture. If this is something you would be interested in attending, either in Albany or D.C., let us know.

One of the greatest events for Schuyler County Farm Bureau is the annual farm tour for all three school districts' sixth grade classes within Schuyler County. A group of approximately 170 sixth graders will tour Bergen Farm on May 30, 2018, where they will have the opportunity to not only see how the farm works every day, but also learn from several agriculture industry professionals about their careers and the education needed related to those careers. This is a great event to showcase local agriculture businesses and show potential careers for the students. 
Agricultural Literacy Week - 2018
