Notice of Onondaga County Farm Bureau Proposed By-Law Change

Section 1. <u>Number and Authority</u>. The business and property of this corporation shall be managed and controlled by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of the president, and vice-president and 78 elected Directors. The term of office shall be three years. There shall not be a term limit for elected directors. In addition, if there is a county Promotion & Education Committee and/or a county Young Farmers and Ranchers committee, the chairman of each shall be an ex-officio member of the Board of Directors with full voting powers.
