A Fíresíde Chat wíth the County Presídent

Dear Fellow Farm Bureau Members:

A couple weeks ago we had Congressman Langworthy come to Telaak Farms for a visit. We had the opportunity to show the Congressman around our facilities and explain how we operate our business here in Mansfield. Overall, it was a good visit. The one thing I found difficult was answering the question of "how can I help?" or "what can I do for you?" The problem realistically being, political representatives all have their own area of influence or laws, rules, and regulations that fall under their control. Congressman Langworthy represents the 23rd congressional district in the House of Representatives in Washington D.C. He has power in representing our area on the federal level, thus only has influence over federal issues. For example, he is a member of the House Agricultural Committee and worked on the new Farm Bill, so we were able to talk about that. But issues like minimum wage is a state issue and he would have no influence or say on those controversies.

To truly best answer the question "how can I help" or questions like it, we all need to think about the different levels of government, from our local township and village governments, to the federal government level. Being ready and/or having the right frame of mind for the level of governmental representation you are talking to/with is ultimately key for communicating how representatives can actually help and allow for better overall communication about the problems that we face as farmers. Being educated about the things we would like to see changed and ideas for how to change them is a powerful thing.

Quickly tell your legislators your opinion!

Tell the Governor to sign the Direct-to-Consumer Shipping Bill

This bill has passed both legislative houses and now awaits the Governor's signature. This bill would allow distilleries and cideries to direct ship to customers rather than requiring customers to come to them. This is already true for wineries.

Tell the Governor to veto the Procurement Bill

This bill has passed both houses and awaits the Governor's signature. This bill would allow municipalities to give procurement preference to products that meet certain standards. Its intention is to increase the use of NYS grown food, but the language, as it is, will give preference to neighboring states, due to the higher cost to do business in NY.

Tell the Governor to sign the Code Council Bill

This bill has passed both houses and awaits the governor's signature. This Bill will add an additional member to the State Fire Prevention and Building Council with an agricultural background.

Tell the Governor to sign the Cannabis Bill

This bill has passed both houses and awaits the Governor's signature. This bill defines cannabis as an agricultural crop.
