



Monroe County Farm Bureau Scholarship Program

The Monroe County Farm Bureau offers a scholarship of \$1,500.00 to a graduating High School Senior or college student up to age 25 who is pursuing a degree in an agriculture related field of study.

Applicants must have a current Monroe County Farm Bureau individual, family, or student membership, and must be continuing their education beyond high school in a trade-school, 2, 4-year, Masters or Doctoral program.

Scholarship forms are available through the Farm Bureau office by calling 518-431-5670.

The award decision will be based on the applicant's involvement with agriculture and the stated intentions to remain involved in agriculture, scholastic participation, application responses and essay.

The Monroe County Farm Bureau Scholarship Committee will review all applications to determine the award recipient.

Completed applications must be returned to the MCFB office no later than **May 1st** of the calendar year. Interviews will be held if necessary. The award recipient will be notified by June 15th.
